#### Bullying

This **two-session workshop** focuses on the issue of bullying, which has become a growing concern among today's youth. It will examine the different forms of bullying, the general characteristics of both a bully and of a victim, as well as the short and long term effects of bullying. Also, the course will take a look at the important role of adult intervention, such as recognizing warning signs, preventing bullying, and caring for a child who is being bullied or is a bully. The course will explore the new Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights and how its provisions have been implemented in New Jersey's school systems.

#### Allegations: It Could Happen to You

This **two-session workshop** will define allegations, violations of regulations and the steps and timeframes of the investigation process. The course will include important aspects, such as, ways to avoid an allegation and the appeals process. It will also touch on the range of emotional responses associated with the ramifications of the findings, whether the result is substantiated or unfounded.
